3. REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR DEVELOPMENT SERVICES - ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 5040, 2020 FOR PORTIONS OF 3553, 3557 AND 3563 VICTORIA DRIVE (PROJ 19-069)

Staff Recommendation:

That Council:

1. Give first reading to City of Coquitlam Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 5040, 2020;

- 2. Refer Bylaw No. 5040, 2020 to Public Hearing;
- 3. Instruct staff to complete the following items prior to Council's consideration of fourth and final reading, should Council grant second and third readings to the Bylaw:
 - a. Submission of a subdivision plan to the satisfaction of the Approving Officer;
 - b. Ensure that all engineering requirements and issues including restrictive covenants, dedications and rights-of-way where necessary, are addressed to the satisfaction of the General Manager Engineering and Public Works;
 - c. Determine the final alignment and design of the Multi-Use Pathway (MUP) to the satisfaction of the General Manager Parks, Recreation and Culture Services;
 - d. Finalization, execution and delivery to the City, the following agreements in Land Title Office registrable form:
 - i. One or more owner-maintained Statutory Rights-of-Way (SRW) in favour of the City over the following:
 - a 4.5 metre (m) (14.8 feet (ft)) wide utility SRW for storm and sanitary mains along the rear of proposed single family lots and through future Lot 8;
 - b. a 4.5 m (14.8 ft) wide pedestrian SRW for a future walkway to be constructed with future Lot 8; and
 - c. a 5.0 m (16.4 ft) wide SRW and Section 219 Restrictive Covenant for the MUP under the BC Hydro Right-of-Way (ROW).
 - ii. Such other Land Title Office registrable agreements as may be required by the City.

 - 4. Pursuant to Section 13 of the Community Charter, SBC 2003, C26, consent to the Villages of Anmore and Belcarra providing mutual aid services in Coquitlam if required as contemplated under Ministerial Order MO84.
