2. Report of the General Manager Finance, Technology and Police Services – Financial Information Data Visualization Pilot Project

The General Manager Finance, Technology and Police Services provided an overview of the scope of the pilot project and the potential applications for the Financial Data Visualization tool.

The Senior Financial Analyst provided an overview of the Financial Data Visualization tool called OpenBook, as developed by Questica. She provided the Committee with a visual demonstration of the Financial Information Data Visualization Pilot Project.

Discussion ensued relative to the following:

- The desire to clarify that the figures provided for projects are funds allocated by Council at that point in time, rather than for the total cost of a project
- Appreciation for the scope and utilization of OpenBook
- Clarification regarding the costs of the pilot project and ongoing licencing fees
- The potential to utilize other tools to enhance the citizen budget
- The desire to provide information to clarify that the operating budgets include capital
- The potential utilization of the technology by other departments to further engage residents
- Clarification regarding the scope of historical data accessible through OpenBook
