Discussion ensued relative to the water quality rehabilitation of the Coquitlam River.

In response to a question from the Committee, the General Manager Engineering and Public Works provided an overview of the work staff have undertaken to support creek water protection and management throughout the City.

Discussion continued relative to the following:

 Potential enforcement options the City could utilize to address illegal dumping into Coquitlam creeks, including increasing fine amounts

- Whether other bodies, such as the Department of Fisheries and Oceans, could be engaged to help with enforcement against illegal dumping The use of the Flowlink water quality monitoring system to increase protection of Coquitlam waterways
- The need for more work around the Stoney Creek watercourse to rehabilitate the creek's water quality
- The desire for the City to lobby the Provincial Government through the Union of BC Municipalities regarding higher fines for illegal dumping

The Committee received the report of the General Manager Engineering and Public Works dated April 24, 2023 and entitled "Creek Water Quality – Citywide Monitoring Results" for information.
