LOOKING OUT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT **Replace Water-Guzzling Toilets** and Receive \$100 Utility Credit

Did you know that toilet flushing accounts for about a quarter of a home's indoor water use? Old-style toilets can use at least seven to eight litres more per flush than newer models. Coquitlam is offering homeowners a \$100 credit on their utility bill for replacing toilets that flush at least 13 litres of water with qualifying new single-flush or dual-flush models – that's a water-use reduction of approximately 30% per flush. The toilet rebate program is a part of Coquitlam's 2021 Enhanced Water Conservation Strategy, which helps conserve water and reduce the pressure on the City's water and sewer system. Nomination Period Now Open for General Local Election


The nomination period is now open for people planning to run for Mayor, Councillor or School Trustee in the general local election in Coquitlam this fall. Anyone running must file nomination papers in person between 9 a.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 30 and 4 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 9.

- In person from the City Clerk's Office on the second floor of City Hall (3000 Guildford Way, Coquitlam, B.C.), from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Candidates should book a brief 10-minute appointment with either the Chief Election Officer or Deputy Chief Election Officer to review and file their nomination documents when they are ready. Appointments may be made by emailing elections@coquitlam.ca or by calling 604-368-7189.
