Now is the time to convert to an energyefficient heat pump. The City is offering a new rebate top-up for Coquitlam households who swap their natural gas, propane or oil heating systems to an electric heat pump – in addition to rebates already being offered by provincial and federal government programs. Heat pumps are the most energy-efficient way to heat or cool a home in B.C. and can replace heat sources, such as a furnace or baseboards, and air conditioners. They are more climate-friendly than heaters, which use fossil fuels and pump greenhouse gases into the environment.

Pop by the Tri-City Home Show this weekend at Poirier Sport and Leisure Complex, visit the City of Coquitlam booth and ask our staff your questions. Rebates provide qualifying homeowners \$350 to \$1,200, depending on their conversion.

Did You Know? **Coquitlam Utility Bill Deadline**

Coquitlam homeowners have a few days left to pay their utility bills before incurring a five per cent penalty.

Utility bills were issued at the end of February and cover the costs for water service, sewer service, garbage and green waste collection. Utility payments are due March 31. After this date, a five per cent penalty will be added to amounts unpaid. For more information, visit
