A key milestone in Coquitlam's Development Application Process, this improved application process will also lead to better quality development applications, reducing the resources and time needed to advance housing and other community amenities.

During the initial phase, the portal will allow the user to submit development applications and pay fees related to those applications with their credit cards. The next phase will expand to renewing business licences and submitting building permits.

Streetscape Enhancement Committee

New murals, feature lighting and more have started to make an appearance across Coquitlam through the City's streetscape enhancement. City staff updated Council recently on the program, which encourages community connection and pride, promotes outdoor living, supports tourism and economic development, and improves safety. Tying in with the City's focus on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, the overarching theme for this year's murals is Belonging and Diversity.

This year's streetscape program will deliver five new murals through a youth team, the kwikwə'əłəm (Kwikwetlem) First Nation and a public call for artists, in addition to other improvements including year-round feature lighting displays, new bike racks, gateway improvements and more.

Helping You Park Responsibly

Coquitlam has city-wide parking regulations to facilitate the safe and efficient movement of emergency vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists and motorists on our public streets. Bylaws are in place that restrict vehicles from parking too close to fire hydrants, intersections, crosswalks or driveways, and there are seasonal restrictions that get implemented in the winter to assist snow clearing.

There are also parking options for commuters around SkyTrain stations, including hundreds of Park and Ride spots in City Centre and Coquitlam Centre Station, a major transit hub. Finally, a one-year parking pass (from date of purchase) is available to residents for use in the parking lots at: City Centre Aquatic Complex, Pinetree Community Centre and Evergreen Cultural Centre.
