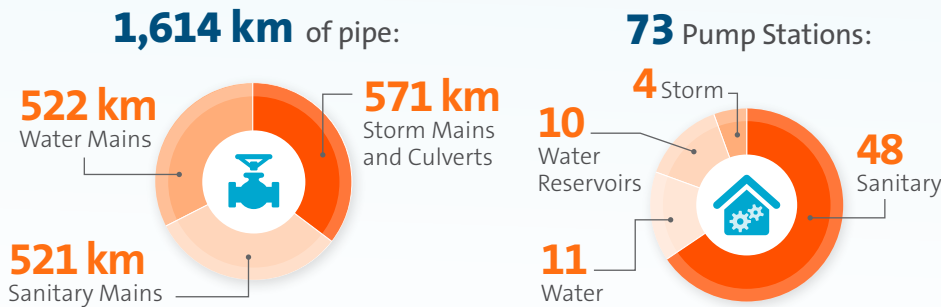


Coquitlam Public Works

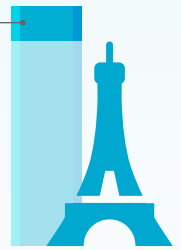
Did You Know?

That is **28 meters** higher than the Eiffel tower.

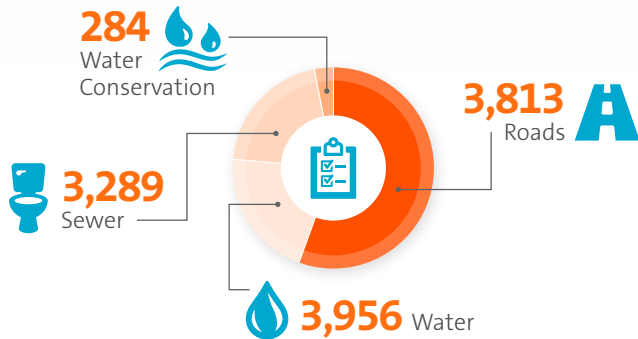


Replacement value of City assets maintained by Public Works: **> \$3 billion**

Work Orders and Service Requests Completed in 2022:

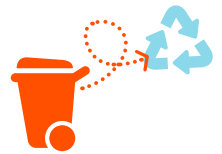


+25,500 residential properties received bi-weekly garbage collection and weekly green waste collection from City.



Two-thirds of the almost **8,700** items collected as part of the Large Item Pick-up program were recycled.

71% of household waste was diverted from the landfill through recycling and waste composting programs.



+225 tonnes of household recyclables were collected at the Town Centre Recycling Depot including:

- Cardboard
- Plastic and overwrap
- Mixed containers
- Foam containers and packaging



83 km of Sanitary Sewers Cleaned



93 km of Water Mains Cleaned



5,650 km of Roads Swept
