OPTIONS, SERVICES, REGULATIONS & FEES

To honor life in the face of loss it is important to us that you are informed and prepared when interment arrangements are needed. The information is specific to City of Coquitlam, Robinson Memorial Park Cemetery.

The Robinson Memorial Park cemetery is open to residents and former residents and those who have family members interred in the cemetery.

Pre-Planning is available for casket burial is offered to residents who are 65+ or have lived in Coquitlam for 20+ consecutive years, or have family members interred in the cemetery.

Pre-planning for cremation burial is offered to residents who have lived in Coquitlam for 3 consecutive years, and former residents 3 consecutive years within the last 10 years, non-residents rates are available.

Definition of a Resident and Family Member (drop down of definitions)

Resident: means any person who resides, or immediately before death resided, in the City and can provide proof in the form of tax notices, utility bills, a property title search or similar document showing that the person was a resident for a continuous period not less than three (3) years immediately before the date of application for a Right of Interment or Interment Permit.

Former Resident: means any person who resided in the City for a continuous period of three years within the ten years immediately before the date of application for a Right of Interment or Interment Permit. Providing proof of same in the form of tax notices, utility bills, a property title search or similar document showing that the person was a resident for a continuous period of three years within the ten years before the date of application, or who swears an affidavit attesting to his or her former residency in the City. *Bylaw No. 5000, 2021 3. Definitions*

Family Member: means parent or step-parent, a grandparent or step-grandparent, a sibling (natural, adopted or step), a spouse, a common-law spouse, a child (natural, adopted or step), a grandchild (natural, adopted or step), a mother-in-law, a father-in-law, or son in-law or a daughter in-law. *Bylaw No. 5000, 2021 3. Definitions*

Right of Interment means a certificate that provides for the future right to inter human remains or cremated remains in a designated lot. The right of interment does not include the ***interment permit (opening and closing of the plot) nor the memorial permit for memorialization.***

Permit fees can typically include:

Administration and permanent record keeping (determining ownership, obtaining permissions and the completion of other documentation which may be required, entering the interment particulars in the interment register, maintaining all legal files.

Preparing the interment location to receive the deceased, placement and closing the grave (locating the grave, excavating, filling and closing the interment space, use of heavy duty equipment. Installation, use and removal of lowering device; placement and removal of artificial grass dressing and/or matts at the grave site, leveling, tamping, re-grading and sodding the grave site; perpetual maintenance of the grave site, including leveling, and re-sodding the grave. Administration and documentation of memorial permits. Preparation and placement, removals, installations of memorial headstones.

GRAVESIDE SERVICE OPTIONS

Watch/Lower: permitted but may be discouraged at certain times of the year.

Watch/Close: permitted but may be discouraged against at certain times of the year.

Graveside: committal services, not watch or close permitted.

Canopies and Tents: available free of charge for inclement weather and shade from heat.

Graveside seating: available free of charge.
