- Updated rental incentives to encourage more rental, affordable and specialneeds housing.
- Provincial legislation limits opportunities for public input.
- Provincial changes to development financing rules change how Coquitlam funds community centres and parks, which may delay capital projects and shift financial burden from developers to taxpayers.
