## **Department Overview**

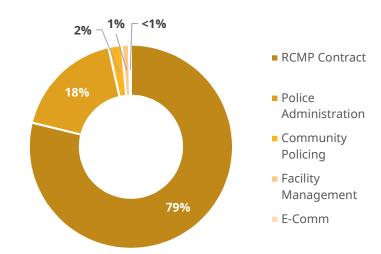

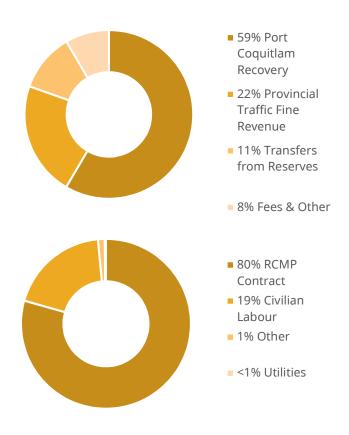

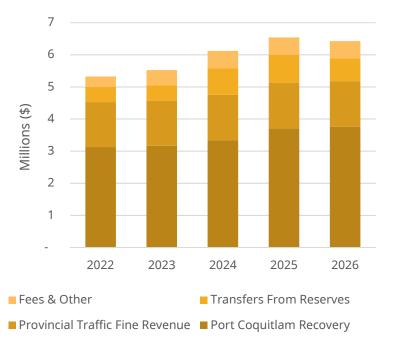

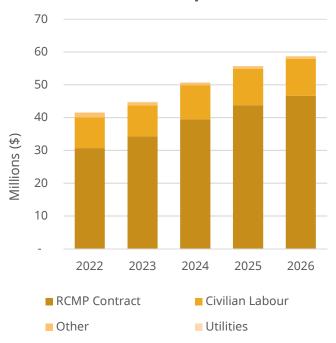
