Proponents shall note the following amendments to the RFP documents:

QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

- Q1. On the site Meeting on Thursday, will we be going to Multiple Sites? Or are we just seeing the one site as an example?
- A1. Only one location for example only.
- Q2. I understand there is a part for our Hourly Rates and Overtime etc. (Time and Materials work) but, the Excel Sheet lists all the specific rooms and locations and asks for a Major PM Cost and a Minor PM Cost. (*So just 2 PM visits per year?)

 I am guessing you would like a cost for the PM's in each of those rooms?
 - a) You have just the Boilers listed for each of the rooms (on the Excel Sheet)
 - b) Will we be quoting on the PM for just the Boilers? Or For Valves, Pumps, Expansion Tanks, Etc.?
 - c) If so, do we have a list of this equipment for each room?
 - d) On the PM for the Boilers, would you like a full Tear-down once a year? (That is usually in the OEM Maintenance)

A2. Answers are:

- a. YES Service Calls will be placed as needed and a PO will be issued.
- b. PM is required for the boilers only. All other equipment should receive a visual inspection. If additional work is needed, it must be documented in the service report and a separate PO will be issued. For urgent issues, contact the City representative for direction.
- c. Not applicable.
- d. Yes, a full annual tear-down is required.
- Q3. Does the City want replacement Ignition Electrodes/ Flame Rods included in the price for the Major Service?
- A3. Replacement should be completed as needed. Please contact the City representative during the service visit for approval prior to replacement.
