Description of Event:

It shall be the sole responsibility of the permit holder to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Fire Prevention and Life Safety Bylaw No. 3712, 2005 and amendments thereto, and any other applicable federal, provincial or municipal statutes, regulations or bylaws. A copy of this permit shall be kept with the location supervisor for the duration of the event.

Criteria for the issuance of a barbeque permit are as follows:

- a) The barbeque is set up on asphalt or similar non-combustible surface.
- b) The area is swept clean of any dried needles or flammable materials before setting up the barbeque.
- c) Cooking is conducted in an open, safe location away from trees, shrubs and dry grass.
- d) Cooking is conducted with certified propane appliances only. Open flame cooking with wood or charcoal briquettes is not permitted.
- e) A fire extinguisher is provided near the cooking area.
- f) Event approval is obtained from Leisure and Parks.
- g) A designated event supervisor is in attendance at all times.
