


## **OAKDALE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK – WHAT WE HEARD**

Throughout the month of May and into early June, 2021, the City engaged with the public on the Oakdale Transportation Network Update (OTNU). This project proposes a revised transportation network for the Oakdale neighbourhood in order to shift the proposed collector route further south, eliminate the need for the Kemsley-Jefferson connector and to create a transportation network that is more feasible to build, with less of an impact on the neighbourhood overall.




We asked, "how supportive are you of the proposed revised streets and lanes network?" You told us:




